Rate Criteria

Carousel Theatre for Young People is committed to providing an accessible, versatile space to the to the Metro Vancouver theatre and arts community. To best serve this community, we provide rates for registered non-profit organizations, theatre companies, and emerging artists. There are three categories which determine a group or individual's rate eligibility, at CTYP's discretion:

Commercial Rate

Commercial rates apply to all groups, organizations and individuals to whom the above categories do not apply. This includes any events, workshops, classes, etc. that charge any kind of fee, admission or tuition, even if the renter otherwise qualifies for the categories above.

Theatre, Arts and Non-Profit Rate

Registered non-profit organizations, theatre industry members (ie. CAEA, PACT, ADC, GVPTA), and theatre and arts rentals have access to reduced rates. Theatre and arts rentals are defined by groups and individuals renting the space for rehearsals, auditions, readings, production meetings, and other non-commercial ventures. Events, workshops, classes, etc. that charge any kind of fee, admission or tuition are **not eligible** for the Theatre, Arts and Non-Profit rate.

Seedlings Rate

Seedlings is a sub-category of Theatre, Arts and Non-Profit rate which has access to a further reduced rates. Seedlings must be registered CAEA co-ops and/or companies who have been registered as a non-profit organization for 3 years or less. Please note that the Seedlings program is only available in July, August and December.
